

All District 60 High Schools will remain 100% virtual until the week of October 19th.

With this, there will be a few changes to our schedules while we are learning virtually. In an effort to maximize quality learning while taking into consideration the 8 plus hours students are in front of a computer screen, our synchronous and asynchronous schedules will be modified.

Beginning next week ALL students will attend virtual classes on Monday and Wednesday in the morning. 1st through 4th hours will be synchronous, then after lunch teachers will provide asynchronous work and will be available for assistance during designated office hours. On Tuesdays and Thursdays teachers will offer office hours for support in the morning while students are working on asynchronous assignments and will instruct students synchronously after lunch for 5th through 7th periods. In other words, classes will be held 1st through 4th hours on Monday and Wednesday, and 5th through 7th hours on Tuesdays and Thursdays. This schedule is posted on our website.

Again, this is for ALL students, regardless of days assigned for our hybrid model. When we return in person during the week of October 19th we will resume with the hybrid model that we have been getting used to these past few weeks.
